JOB POSTING: Lead Mobile Maintenance Technician

The Lead Mobile Maintenance Technician will be responsible for keeping light and heavy-duty mobile equipment and generators operational and fueled (as necessary). Heavy-duty equipment on site will include, but is not limited to: D5 dozers, excavators, skid steers, a grader, a loader, and Marookas; equipment is of various makes (Caterpillar, Case, and Volvo). Light-duty equipment includes Ford pick-ups, snow machines, and ATVs.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Comply with safety & health, environmental and Company policies and procedures.
- Provide leadership and hands-on training to mobile maintenance technicians.
- Troubleshoot, repair, and maintain mobile equipment and generators.
- Perform preventative maintenance regularly on all equipment.
- Update maintenance record logs.
- Assist with general camp maintenance as necessary.
- Complete pre-shift inspection and field level risk assessments.
- Maintain a clean work area and accountable for the proper care of Company tools and equipment.
- Other duties as assigned by supervision and may include providing support in other departments as necessary.

While performing the duties of this job, employees may be frequently required to stand, walk, or sit for extended periods of time, use hand and fingers to handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, regularly required to talk and hear. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 75 pounds. Specific vision requirements for this position include close vision, distance vision, and the ability to adjust focus.

This position is a 2 week on 2 weeks off rotation. The 2022 field season has an anticipated duration from the end of January through Fall 2022. The successful candidate must successfully pass a post-offer physical and drug screen and criminal background clearance.
