- Work with the Donlin CR team to develop partnership opportunities that mutually benefit communities and Donlin Gold to meet the four key community investment criteria: Health and Wellness, Education and Training, Environmental Stewardship, and Economic Development as described in the Stakeholder Engagement Plan priorities.
- Offer support and partnership and work with the Bethel Community Services Foundation for local initiatives, including but not limited to the Navigator program for vulnerable and homeless youth, Yuut Elitnaurviat Learning Center, and Association of Village Council Presidents.
- Comply with Company Safety, Environmental and other Company policies and procedures.
