Donlin Gold is recruiting for Lead Facilities Technician for one of the world's largest undeveloped gold deposits, owned and operated by Donlin Gold LLC, which is owned equally by affiliates of Barrick Gold and NOVAGOLD Resources. Donlin Gold is expected to be one of just a handful of gold mines worldwide that produces more than one million ounces of gold annually. Gold mineralization exists in intrusive dikes & sills hosted by sandstones, siltstones, and shales of the Kuskokwim Group. Mineralization generally associated with arsenopyrite, pyrite and stibnite.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Lead Facilities Maintenance Technician will be primarily responsible for keeping Donlin Camp facilities operational. Facilities to be maintained or repaired include kitchen, offices, power generation, heating, bathrooms, sleeping quarters, and other facilities. This position is a 2-weeks on 2-weeks off rotation. The successful candidate must successfully pass a post-offer physical and drug screen and criminal background clearance.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Comply with safety and environmental policies and procedures.
- Provide leadership and hands-on training with heating, domestic water, and wastewater systems.
- Repair and maintain camp facilities and other structures.
- Schedule and preform preventative maintenance on necessary systems.
- Maintain inventory and order parts and equipment necessary to preform duties.
- Monitor fuel levels daily and assist with regular fuel deliveries.
- Maintains a clean work area and accountable for the proper care of Company tools and equipment.
- Other duties as assigned by supervision and may include providing support in other departments as necessary.

While performing the duties of this job, employees may be frequently required to stand, walk, or sit for extended periods of time, use hand and fingers to handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, regularly required to talk and hear. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 75 pounds. Specific vision requirements for this position include close vision, distance vision and the ability to adjust focus.

- Four years minimum experience in a maintenance related field preferred.
- Experience with Toyo stoves required.
