JOB POSTING – SAFETY COORDINATOR

This position will be located at our remote camp and the work schedule will be 2 weeks on 2 weeks off rotation (12 hours per day) and will support a temporary drilling program. The project is located in Western Alaska. The Safety Coordinator will review, evaluate and analyze work environments and design programs and procedures to control, eliminate, and prevent disease or injury caused by chemical, physical, and biological agents or ergonomic factors. Conduct inspections and enforce adherence to laws and regulations governing the health and safety of individuals.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Comply with safety, environmental and Company policies and procedures.
- Collaborate with Staff and Leadership to institute control and remedial measure for hazardous and potentially hazardous conditions or equipment.
- May collect samples of dust, gases, vapors, and other potentially toxic materials for analysis.
- Conduct audits associated with the Donlin Project sites and participate in the site investigations.
- Conduct safety training and education programs and demonstrate the use of safety equipment.
- Coordinate HazCom programs regarding hazardous chemicals and other substances.
- Inspect and evaluate workplace environments, equipment, and practices, in order to ensure compliance with safety standards and government regulations.
- Inspect specified areas to ensure the presence of fire prevention equipment, safety equipment, and first-aid supplies.
- Investigate accidents to identify causes and to determine how such accidents might be prevented in the future. Investigate health-related complaints and inspect facilities to ensure that they comply with public health legislation and regulations and other related conditions as required.
- Update and maintain the emergency response plans and procedures.
- Provide new hire orientations and develop or assist in the development of materials for these presentations.
- Recommend measures to help protect workers from potentially hazardous work methods, processes, or materials.
- Other duties as assigned.
